

FAIR USE POLICY

UNISCOPE COMMUNICATIONS

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Fair Use

This policy explains "Fair Use" as it pertains to your Uniscope service in a simple, bullet-point form. Failing to follow the restrictions set out in this policy may result in suspension or termination of your service. It is important to note that all Uniscope services are intended specifically for use by business entities, and this Fair Use policy reflects those intentions.

Unlimited Downloads & Uploads

All Uniscope Communications internet services come without limits on upload or download traffic. However, 'unlimited' does not imply 'infinite' data, as the following points explain.

Fair Usage Policies

Unreasonable Use:

- Any use deemed to be excessive at the discretion of Uniscope Communications, where it contributes toward an abnormal amount of bandwidth congestion or contention.
- Reselling or wholesaling the service, or otherwise sharing the service in any way across multiple physical premises or business entities without prior consent from Uniscope Communications.

Unacceptable Use:

- Use of your service, in part or in full, knowingly or unknowingly, to commit any act that you are not legally entitled to do so.
- Use of your service, in part or in full, knowingly or unknowingly, to harass any person or entity.
- Use of your service in any way that, knowingly or unknowingly causes damage to or otherwise hinders the operation of any computer or telecommunications network that you (the client) does not own and operate.
- Use of your service in any way, knowingly or unknowingly, that damages or hinders the operation of the Uniscope Communications and/or its clients network(s).
- Use of the service that violates the Terms & Conditions of the contract.

Breach of Fair Use Policy

In all cases, you will be notified if we believe you have breached the Fair Use Policy. In the event of any suspected Unreasonable or Unacceptable use, you will be contacted by our staff to discuss the details of the suspected breach with us, along with any possible resolutions to the breach. Any breach that is deemed unresolvable (solely at Uniscope Communications' discretion) will result in either suspension or termination of your service contract.
